Beer Burros were ready to help serve and create a fun environment

### Financial Information:

Generous Sponsors from friends helped with band, food, beverage and decorating, paper expenses and beer burros  
The social fundraising event had \$6,037.47 in income and \$3,314.46 in expenses for a net profit of \$2,723.46

**Timeline:**

Design and concept was created during the summer of 2019, but the event was cancelled in Spring 2020. Formal meetings started during the summer of 2020 and monthly meetings via zoom, email and in person on a monthly basis.

**Volunteer Requirements:**

Planning committee included LSG President, President Elect, VP Membership, Spring Party Committee, Maestro of the LSO, and Volunteers to assist with mailings.

**Impact on Community:**

The social created a lot of excitement in the community. The community needed the spirit of friendly good fellowship. Once the vaccinations for COVID-19 were making the number of cases drop, the friends of the LSG and the LSO were ready to celebrate.
